"Uncle Charley" Shawhan, one of the oldest and best known citizens of Lone Jack and Van Buren township, died last Saturday afternoon at his home and was buried on Sunday afternoon, his funeral occurring at the Christian church at that place.

"Mr. Shawhan was 78 years old and had lived in Lone Jack neighborhood a great many years and was universally loved and will be sadly missed by the good people out there."
