

Anniversary of Lone Jack.

The Lone Jack celebration yesterday, in memory of the battle fought at that place during the civil war on Aug. 15 and 16, 1861, attracted a great crowd, which was variously estimated at from 8,000 to 15,000. The occasion was of special interest

because of the presence of Major L. R. Foster,¹ who was at the time of the battle a resident of Johnson county, Mo., and in command of the Federal forces. Speeches were made by Major Foster, Hon. John H. Taylor, Lieut. Mr. Hafferty and others. The celebration was an entire success.
