Attend—Lone Jack's Battle.

Judge Phillips left this morning for Warrensburg where, to-day and to-morrow, the first reunion of his regiment, the Seventh, will be held. Ex-Governor Crittenden left last night. He was Judge Phillips's lieutenant colonel. Colonel Emery Foster was the first major in the regiment and was wounded in the battle of Lone Jack fought twenty-seven years ago to-day. It was in this battle that Judge Phillips's regiment first participated in an engagement. Major Emery Foster is the gentleman with whom John N. Edwards fought a duel.
