 years of age, *5* feet *11* inches high, *fair* complexion, *blue* eyes,  
*light* hair, and by occupation when enlisted a *Farmer*. During the last two

I CERTIFY, that I have carefully examined the said *Joseph Putthoff* of  
 Captain *Hocum's* Company, and find him incapable of performing the duties of a soldier  
 because of (Here insert par. 1295, p. 391, also, par. 1026, p. 495, and directions on Form 13, p. 325, Revised Army Regulations) *Hemorrhoids*  
*of 6 weeks form and an injury of the walls of the abdomen.*  
*The disease of the abdomen produced by stumbling of horse throwing*  
*him violently on the horn of saddle. Said disability did not*  
*exist prior to enlistment.*
