

**W. L. Roney for Probate Judge.**

W. L. Roney, candidate for Probate Judge on the republican ticket, was in the city last Friday getting acquainted with the voters of this part of the county. Mr. Roney is an old soldier and has been a faithful party worker. He is an old resident of the north west part of the county. He was formerly a mail carrier but resigned. He needs your vote on Aug. 4th and asks you to vote for him.

The Marquette Tribune said last week: "W. L. Roney, candidate for Probate Judge, is one of the most patriotic citizens in the county. At much expense and labor he has made a cement monument on the Lone Jack battle field near K. C. Mo. Mr. Roney was an active participant in this engagement and since the Union soldiers won the fight he feels that some enduring memorial should be left on the ground. The monument he has made is about eight feet high and sixteen inches square with appropriate cap and base. Three smooth faces are made in the column. On the top face is painted these words, "Dedicated Aug. 16, 1908, to the brave men of Co. F., 8th M. S. M. Cav., who died in defence of the Union and the Flag Aug. 16, 1862." In the center face is a brass badge of the G. A. R and about it will be painted the names of all the survivors of said company. It is an appropriate and fitting memorial and Mr. Roney's comrades should appreciate his efforts in erecting this monument."
