

LONE JACK MONUMENT WAITING.

W. L. Roney Appeals to the County Court for Permission to Erect It.

W. L. Roney of Marquette, Kas., asked the county court in Independence, Mo., yesterday for permission to erect a war monument on the battle field of Lone Jack. Mr. Roney took part in the battle as a captain of the Third Indiana Battery. The monument he desires to erect is now in storage in knocked-down form in Lee's Summit. He shipped it there last year with the intention of erecting the monument in time for the Lone Jack picnic, but he was threatened with an injunction and desisted. If he can now get permission he would like to go ahead and have the monument up by the date of the next picnic.
